

### Sacred Heart Parish, Bordon

Last weekend we celebrated the Divine Mercy of God and we heard in the Gospel that His Mercy has a condition – that we Confess our sins.

We heard how God the Son breathed on the Apostles and sent them out just as He Himself was sent – to forgive sins, to call people to change and repent.

The Lord reminds us of this in today's Gospel:

"So you see how it is written that the Christ would suffer and on the third day rise from the dead, and that, in his name, repentance for the forgiveness of sins would be preached to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses to this."

We live in an age that is desperate to excuse sin and explain it away, denying sin at every cost – even the cost of their own spiritual wellbeing and mental health.

We continue to pray today for all those who are in need of God's mercy, healing and peace, but wilfully refuse it. May they find their way to the Lord.

## **GIFT AID**

Anyone who pays income tax on pensions, wages etc can complete a **Gift Aid form** and increase whatever they offer to the parish by 25% at no extra cost to them (the taxman donates it to the parish from what you have already paid him!)



Another way to support the parish (at no extra cost to you!) is to do your online shopping through 'Easyfundraisng'. By doing this the companies you shop with will donate from your bill to the parish.



We have so many volunteers in the parish, helping to make things run smoothly and we are indebted to them. We have such a 'can do' attitude with no task being too much trouble! The more volunteers we have, however, the lighter the load, so during Eastertide we traditionally think about ways we might be involved in the life of the parish:

**Reading at Mass:** Publicly proclaiming the Word of God is a privilege but it takes courage! Training is given and the commitment is generally once every 4 weeks or so. **(Speak to Father)** 

**Altar serving:** Serving at God's altar is also a privilege. It is a weekly commitment and training is given. **(Speak to Deacon Kim)** 

**Projector:** Would you like to help with the projector? Fr John produces the slides, videos, etc. At present there is no rota, but we hope to form one. We hope the commitment will be once every three weeks. (Speak to Martin)

**Tea and Coffee:** are you able to help with serving tea and coffee after Sunday Mass? There is a rota, and the commitment is generally once a month? (Speak to Magdalena)

**Flower arranging:** are you creative? Would you like to be part of the flower arranging team? The main commitment is Christmas and Easter and certain Solemnities. **(Speak to Helen)** 

**Friday soups:** would you like to be part of the soup making team? The commitment is once a month or so to produce a soup with all proceeds going to the Parish Funds. (Speak to Rebecca)

Website and media: Would you like to help out with the parish website and/ or social media platforms or producing information leaflets / booklets? (Speak to Father)

Parish Schola: A group of singers to help lead Mass parts, psalms and other chants used throughout the year at Mass. (Speak to Jeanneth)



This Eastertide, as we pray for the coming of God the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, we pray in a particular way for our Parish. Each week we will pray for all those who live and work in neighbouring streets, presenting them to Almighty God, asking that when our Mission Team visit them, they will be moved by God's grace and respond generously to His Calling out to them.
