GIFT AID

Anyone who pays income tax on pensions, wages etc can complete a **Gift Aid form** and increase whatever they offer to the parish by 25% at no extra cost to them (the taxman donates it to the parish from what you have already paid him!)



Another way to support the parish (at no extra cost to you!) is to do your online shopping through 'Easyfundraisng'. By doing this the companies you shop with will donate from your bill to the parish.



We have so many volunteers in the parish, helping to make things run smoothly and we are indebted to them. We have such a 'can do' attitude with no task being too much trouble! The more volunteers we have, however, the lighter the load, so during Eastertide we traditionally think about ways we might be involved in the life of the parish:

Reading at Mass: Publicly proclaiming the Word of God is a privilege but it takes courage! Training is given and the commitment is generally once every 4 weeks or so. **(Speak to Father)**

Altar serving: Serving at God's altar is also a privilege. It is a weekly commitment and training is given. **(Speak to Deacon Kim)**

Projector: Would you like to help with the projector? Fr John produces the slides, videos, etc. At present there is no rota, but we hope to form one. We hope the commitment will be once every three weeks. (Speak to Martin)


Tea and Coffee: are you able to help with serving tea and coffee after Sunday Mass? There is a rota, and the commitment is generally once a month? (Speak to Magdalena)

Flower arranging: are you creative? Would you like to be part of the flower arranging team? The main commitment is Christmas and Easter and certain Solemnities. **(Speak to Helen)**

Friday soups: would you like to be part of the soup making team? The commitment is once a month or so to produce a soup with all proceeds going to the Parish Funds. (Speak to Rebecca)

Website and media: Would you like to help out with the parish website and/ or social media platforms or producing information leaflets / booklets? (Speak to Father)

Parish Schola: A group of singers to help lead Mass parts, psalms and other chants used throughout the year at Mass. (Speak to Jeanneth)

The church has a whole treasury of prayers, novenas and devotions that help to focus our prayers and help us to meditate.

The month of May is dedicated to Mary and to mark this as a parish we will:

- Say the Rosary before the 10am Mass each Sunday in May.
- We will Pray the Angelus instead of the Hail Mary at every Mass.
- After Mass on Sunday 5th May we will process out to the Grotto and crown Mary, bringing flowers of the rarest and blossoms the fairest.
- On 13th May we will bless and enthrone the statues of Jacintha, Francisco and Lucia in the Grotto.

Individually, why not consider:

- Praying the Rosary at Home daily
- Learning some of the most well-known Prayers:
 - (1) The Hail Holy Queen
 - (2) The Memorare
 - (3) The Magnificat
 - (4) The Prayer for England
 - (5) Pausing at Midday to pray the Angelus.
- Read about some of the Apparitions of Mary and the messages She has brought to us from Heaven.
- Find the Passages in Scripture where Mary is referred to.
- Learn from the Church's Teaching on Mary and some of the 'Ex Cathedra' doctrines that the church has proclaimed.


