## Jeremiah

God decided that Jeremiah would be his prophet. A prophet is a messenger of God. He told Jeremiah to tell the people that they were to behave. Jeremiah didn't want to do this, he knew people wouldn't want to listen to him.
God told him to go where he said and that he would tell Jeremiah what to say and then he touched Jeremiah's mouth. God gave Jeremiah the courage, wisdom and strength to speak out but not even the king would listen to him. The priests got angry with him and wanted him to stop talking about God.
But Jeremiah reminded them all how God had helped them beat their enemies before but now the enemies were on the march again. Still the people would not listen. The king threw him into prison but he still kept on preaching about God. The king threw him into a deep, muddy dungeon but still Jeremiah continued to preach.
In the end, the king listened to Jeremiah but it was too late. The enemies had conquered the people of God and they were taken into captivity for the next 70 years.
