November is the month dedicated to the Faithful Departed – those who have ‘gone before us marked with the sign of Faith’.

We begin today by honouring and celebrating All the Saints (All Hallows) who are the men and women who are now in God’s Company in Heaven. Those members of the church are called ‘Church Triumphant’. We ask them to pray for us.

On Monday we celebrate the ‘Holy Souls in Purgatory’. These members of the church are known as ‘Church Suffering’ and they are our brothers and sisters in faith, who left this world in God’s friendship but not in a perfect state - they had some atoning to do.

We ask the Saints (The church Triumphant) to pray for us, and in our turn we (church militant) pray for the Holy Souls (the Church Suffering).

The church exists in these three states and so long as we are in a state of grace, we are in communion with one another.

Family learning from the Catechism:

In this month dedicated to the Holy Souls, let's take a closer look at what the church teaches about Purgatory:

1030 All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven.

1031 The Church gives the name Purgatory to this final purification of the elect, which is entirely different from the punishment of the damned.⁶⁰⁴ The Church formulated her doctrine of faith on Purgatory especially at the Councils of Florence and Trent. the tradition of the Church, by reference to certain texts of Scripture, speaks of a cleansing fire.

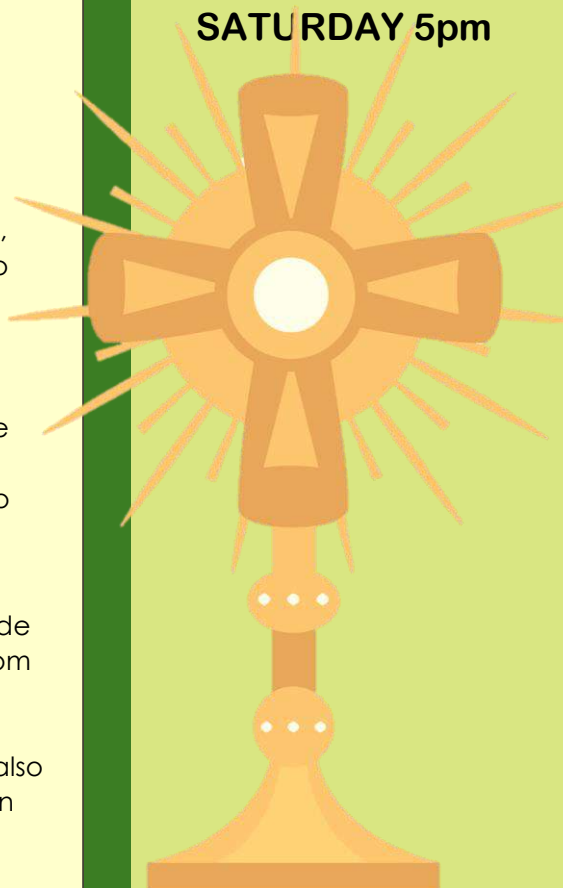
1032 This teaching is also based on the practice of prayer for the dead, already mentioned in Sacred Scripture: "Therefore Judas Maccabeus] made atonement for the dead, that they might be delivered from their sin."⁶⁰⁷ From the beginning the Church has honoured the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God. The Church also commends almsgiving, indulgences, and works of penance undertaken on behalf of the dead.
