FATHER MARK WRITES: CHOOSE THE WAY OF LIFE AND BLESSING

"There are two Ways, one of Life and one of Death, and there is a great difference between the two Ways."

These are the opening lines of the [*Didache*](#), a first century Christian catechism used to teach new Christians the essence of the Christian Faith. The Way of Life is the WAY Jesus IS. and JESUS IS the only WAY that leads to eternal life.

Today's Gospel is from the beginning of the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus's great teaching to his disciples and the crowds. This opening section has been given the name, 'the Beatitudes', because Jesus names eight blessings. These in turn point out eight ways in which we can welcome God into our lives and commit to God's ways. They are the paths to true happiness and the 'values' of the Kingdom of God and are lived out fully in Jesus. When we become more Christ-like, when we live by his values and not those of the world, then we are choosing the Way of Jesus, the Way of Life, which leads to eternal blessing in heaven.

Over these next few weeks, our parish is providing some beautiful opportunities for all to receive and offer blessings. Do spread the word!

Light of the World – A Place for All

Jesus is "the Light to enlighten all peoples" (c.f. Luke 2:32). In the darkness of winter, we long for light - light that warms, guides, and gives hope. Jesus is that Light and this week, we invite you to encounter that light in a new way in St. Peter's Church.

For three evenings, our church will be transformed into a place of beauty and wonder. Stunning illuminations will bring to the building to life in a new way whilst choral music and Gregorian chant will lift hearts heavenward. It is more than an event - it is a celebration of 100 years of this building welcoming people from all nations and allowing them to experience the Light of Christ's Love. This is a once in a lifetime opportunity.

Jesus calls us to be light-bearers too. In next Sunday's Gospel, He will say to us: "You are the light of the world". We do this as individuals and as a parish - through ministries like SVP and the Welcome Hub, and in partnership with others, such as through Basics Bank and Street Pastors. Every act of love pushes back the darkness.

The cross keys of St Peter speak a quiet truth – each and every person who comes through the doors of our churches has been given the keys to these places of encounter. The invitation is to come in, pray, rest, and know you are loved.

Parking at Winton House – Important Notice (St Peter's Church): We wish to reiterate last week's message regarding parking at Winton House. Parishioners are advised that there is currently no authorised permission for us to park in this location. Anyone choosing to do so does so entirely at their own risk.

We have been informed that at least one parishioner has already received a Penalty Notice after parking at Winton House on a Sunday morning. Unfortunately, this confirms that there is a genuine risk of further notices being issued. At present, we therefore ask all parishioners to refrain from parking at Winton House. While discussions are ongoing with the tenants to explore whether permission might be granted in the future, this remains work in progress, and no approval has yet been given.
